



CHOOSE YOUR FUTURE - AT A GLANCE

Redcol's College Counseling Program

- In Middle School, students explore themselves and their interests with the Choose Your Future curriculum, guided by their homeroom teachers, school psychologist, and other staff members.
- In High School, students continue with the Choose Your Future curriculum, however, the emphasis here is on naming their vocation, in addition to career exploration and university selection.
- All High School students have an International College Counselor, in addition to a high school psychologist.

The programming for students and families includes:

- Activities for students from 6th through 12th grade to explore who they are and what they want for their future and to connect this to career and university selection
- Choose Your Future webinar series, with experts speaking on different topics each month.
- Workshops for parents and students to explore their grade's big themes
- College Fairs
- College Tours

9th Grade: Setting the Foundation

- Students should focus on establishing a strong GPA and getting more involved in activities that they enjoy.
- Freshman receive a Maia Learning account and training on its use.
- In their first year, students use Maia Learning to explore their strengths, passions, and how they connect to possible career interests.
- College Counselors provide group programming as well as individual appointments upon request
- Students and parents are invited to participate in the Choose Your Future series and other programming shared by the College Counselor and the Choose Your Future team

10th Grade: Exploration Phase

- Students use Maia Learning to begin exploring colleges and universities with programs related to their career interests.
- Sophomores take the PSAT10 in March/April
- College Counselors provide group programming and individual appointments upon request.
- Students can participate in college representative visits on their campus.
- Sophomores are invited to participate in college tours to national universities in Bogotá, Medellín y/o Cali, in addition to their local universities if they live outside of these cities; additionally, they are invited to consider participating in international college visits.
- Students and parents are invited to participate in the Choose Your Future series and other programming shared by the College Counselor and the Choose Your Future team

11th Grade: Preparing to Apply

- Juniors are required to begin meeting with their College Counselor after November 15th to discuss college lists and testing timeline.
- Juniors use Maia Learning to narrow down their college choices and begin organizing the components of their applications.
- Students can participate in college representative visits on their campus.
- Juniors are invited to participate in college tours to national universities in Bogotá, Medellín y/o Cali, in addition to their local universities if they live outside of these cities; additionally, they are invited to consider participating in international college visits.
- Students take the TOEFL in May.
- Students and parents are invited to participate in the Choose Your Future series and other programming shared by the College Counselor and the Choose Your Future team

12th Grade: Application and Admission Cycle

- Seniors meet with their College Counselor to review their final college list and work on college and scholarship applications, as well as review essays and resumes.
- Application Labs are held in school to assist students with completing college and scholarship applications.
- Students can participate in college representative visits on their campus.
- Students and parents are invited to participate in the Choose Your Future series and other programming shared by the College Counselor and the Choose Your Future team
- Seniors are guided through the decision-making process, all the way up to when they make their final decision of where they will be attending.
- Seniors will also have access to workshops related to independent living and acculturation in new countries or new cities.
